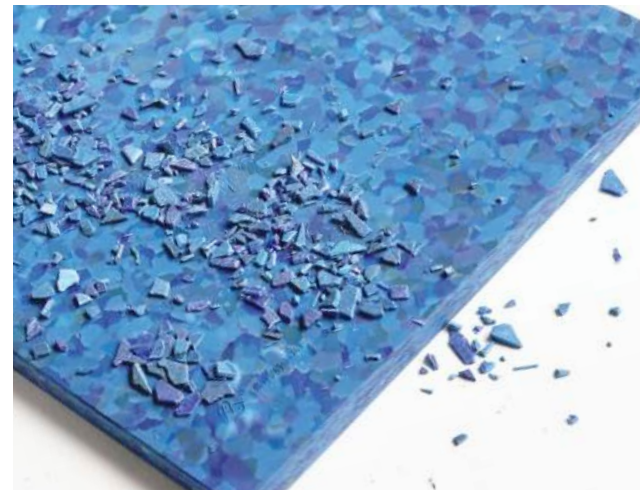


PANELS WITH A COLORFUL PAST

A SUSTAINABLE, GREEN SURFACE MATERIAL

As the consequences of climate change become more and more present, architects, builders, and the design industry are increasingly including sustainability criteria in the spaces we inhabit and occupy.

Polygood® is made from a single type of plastic — that makes it a 100% recyclable material.

The choice of materials is a fundamental aspect of a building's positive impact on people, society, and the planet. Meanwhile, The Good Plastic Company is on a mission to make its own positive impact: transforming the world's plastic waste into a material that can be replicated at scale for large design projects.

This is why Polygood® was developed, to help companies choose upcycled, waste-free materials to make beautiful and functional furniture, flooring, display fixtures, cladding, facades, and just about anything that wood or conventional solid surface options can create.

Since 2018, the company has not only transformed a significant amount of plastic for use in hotels and restaurants, but has also helped projects to meet BREEAM or LEED criteria when using Polygood®, thanks to the eco-friendly Global Warming Potential and environmental certifications detailed here.

Global Warming Potential

Global Warming Potential (GWP) is a crucial metric for building materials as it quantifies their contribution to climate change, allowing architects and builders to make environmentally-conscious choices.

Polygood® has a GWP of only 1,074.82 pounds per tonne, which is eight times lower than using virgin polystyrene and six times more eco-friendly than a leading solid surface material.

Based on this data — which measures levels of CO₂, CH₄, N₂O, and other gases — we continue to benchmark our low-emission manufacturing processes and material sourcing against other surface material manufacturers to maintain our positive environmental impact.

CERTIFICATIONS THAT AFFIRM OUR ENVIRONMENTAL ACCOUNTABILITY

Our Life Cycle Assessment provides full transparency, from raw material sourcing to panel manufacturing and end-of-life product recycling. We are closing the waste loop and ensuring projects meet environmental standards.

We take pride in being the only manufacturer of a recycled plastic material that holds Cradle to Cradle® Bronze certification. This rigorous, third-party program evaluates and recognises Polygood® as a C2C material that makes positive environmental and social impacts.



Low VOC material *Global*

Our VOC A+ rating means our products have minimal volatile organic compound emissions, contributing to healthier indoor environments. Polygood® aligns with BREEAM and LEED standards for construction materials in the UK and EU, making it a low-VOC emitting material.



Food contact safe *European Union, United Kingdom*

Polygood® is certified as safe for food contact. This certification is in accordance with European Commission Regulation No. 10/2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food. The certification process involves rigorous testing and analysis to ensure that our materials meet the highest safety standards.

Independent testing confirms that Polygood® contains no chemicals or substances listed under California's Proposition 65. We verify this through VOC emissions testing and full material composition analysis. Polygood® is safe for indoor use and supports health-conscious design decisions.
